



Regulations for exhibitors of Florence WILD of 23-24 November 2019

Each exhibitor is required to follow the following rules:

ORGANIZATION DATE and TIMES

MDexpo S.R.L.S. (here also identified as "organizer" or "organization") organizes in Calenzano, Florence WILD, which will take place on 23-24 November 2019 at the sports hall, via di Prato 64, 50041, Calenzano (FLORENCE). The organizer reserves the right to change the duration, opening and closing dates and times of the event, without this entailing any right of compensation for exhibitors. Hours: Saturday 10:00 am - 7:00 pm, Sunday 10:00 am - 7:00 pm. To leave the exhibition premises before this time, you will have to pay a penalty of € 500.00 considered as damage to the image of the event. Admission is charged: full ticket € 8.00, reduced € 5.00 for children between 6 and 12, under 6 years free entry. The organization reserves the right to establish and modify the daily opening and closing times of the Exhibition. Exhibitors and their employees are allowed to enter the premises one hour before opening. They are obliged to leave the premises within half an hour of closing. Permanence beyond this limit is not permitted.

Art. I

Each exhibitor is required to supervise his / her own station during the entire opening time of the event, he / she will have to contain his / her own set up within the assigned surface identifiable by means of special signs on the floor. The participant is prohibited from deteriorating the floors and walls of the stand and raising them with the set-up beyond the set height limits, as well as using the wall structures to hang signs and the like. Any exceptions must be discussed and evaluated with the organization.

Art. II PURPOSE

The exhibition is organized in order to enhance the pet sector by creating a meeting point for breeders, associations, traders and end users.

Art. III

PRODUCT SECTORS AND EXPOSED PRODUCTS

Pets and income - Accessories - Feed - Books - Periodicals - Gadgets - Country dances, clothing and country accessories - Aquatic, fat and similar plants, ornamental greenery, street food, local food and wine.

Art. IV

MAY PARTICIPATE

All categories of Italian and foreign operators in the sectors concerning pets and animals (PET), zoophilia. Other commercial operators not specifically included in the above mentioned sectors are admitted at the discretion of the organizer.

Regulations for exhibitors of Florence WILD of 23-24 November 2019

Each exhibitor is required to follow the following rules:

Art. V
CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

For admission to the exhibition you need:

a) - submit an application form on the appropriate form, attached to this letter

Regulation addressing it to the organizer;

b) - to pass a quota equal to 50% of the amount of the rent for the areas pre-registered, at the time

of the presentation of the admission application;

c) - pass the balance of the fee for the areas booked together with the registration fee and others

accessory fees by and no later than 31 October 2019;

d) - pass the registration fee: breeders module € 50.00 dogs and € 25.00 cats - stand without

or with dividing panels and dedicated island tables € 100.00. The presentation of the application implies acceptance of all the rules and regulations of the Exhibition by the applicant.

Art. VI

ACCEPTANCE OF THE APPLICATION AND ASSIGNMENT OF THE STANDS

The organizers will decide in absolute autonomy and at their sole discretion whether or not to accept the application form with the sole obligation to specify the reasons for the non-acceptance for the timely requests of exhibitors who formally request them. In case of non-acceptance, the amount paid will be refunded. The assignment of the stands is made on the basis of the data indicated on the application form, data that for the desired stand are to be considered purely indicative and do not bind the organizers in any way nor can they condition the application for participation. The times and procedures for setting up the exhibition spaces (stands) are as follows: Friday 22 November from 9.00 to 20.00.

The exhibition tables have no cover and it is up to the exhibitor to arrange for them to be set up; they must remain in the position in which they are located, any displacements given by necessity must be requested and approved by the organization. The following fees are included in the participation fee and registration fee: exhibition area rental, general surveillance and order service, general cleaning of common areas, waste disposal, general lighting, assistance to exhibitors. Instead, the participant is responsible for: setting up and furnishing inside the stands, special connection rights for: water, telephones, electricity, compressed air and related consumption, insurance, cleaning inside the stand, shunts at the stands of pipes for additional electricity, water, compressed air. Specifically, electricity, when exclusive for its own stand, is supplied at a cost of € 100.00 (excluding VAT). The current is free only for the table islands if the connection was communal with other exhibitors.

Art.VII
REMOVAL

Removal and preparation of stands can be carried out at the following times: starting from 7.30pm on 11/24/2019 until 11.00pm and Monday 11/25/2019 June from 8.00am, 30 at 12.30. The exhibitor is obliged to return the stand in the same state in which he was given, making it clear to the organization of the Exhibition. Any damage must be promptly recast. After this deadline, the organization does not assume any obligations or responsibilities for the stand or the material left in the stand that may be returned to the exhibitor at its total expense and risk by the organization, without liability for any shortages, breakages, etc. .., resulting from removal or sending.

Art. VIII
FACULTY OF RETENTION

The organizer without any responsibility for any consequences, reserves the right not to allow the output of the exhibited materials, in the event of contractual non-fulfillment by 2 of 8

Exhibitor. The organizer is not responsible for any damage to the exhibition materials that may occur in the application of the aforementioned right, inappellable judgment of the organization, with the regulation, that disturbs the sight of the complex of the pavilion, that it is harmful towards the adherent stands or to the public.

Art. IX
UTILITIES

Exhibitors on the tables will be provided with free electricity supply and an electrical panel will be available with industrial outlets within a maximum distance of 20 meters, and water within the limits of the facilities available to the Exhibition. All extraordinary installations of supply systems as well as any changes to existing systems must be previously requested to the organization which, in the event of acceptance of the application, will directly provide it to its specialized personnel, charging all expenses to the requesting Exhibitor . The cost for the connection of dedicated electricity (see stands / exhibition stands) is € 100.00 (VAT excluded).

Art. X
SERVICE CARDS (PASS)

Each exhibiting company has the right to free passes depending on the exhibition space (stand) purchased. From 1 to 3 tables up to 2 passes. From 4 to 6 tables up to 3 passes. From 7 or more tables up to 4 passes. Box (3x2) up to 3 passes. For stands up to 16 square meters up to 5 passes. For stands over 16 square meters up to 7 passes.

Art. XI
STAND

The exhibition spaces are made available without installation, unless otherwise agreed with the organizer and each arrangement remains the responsibility of the participant. The setting up of the stands must be carried out with the prior consent of the organizers, for this purpose the set-up project must be presented in due time to the organizers and only after approval by the organization itself can work be started. As far as backdrops, partitions and signs are concerned, the following must be stated: 1) For wall stands, the seabed is allowed up to mt. 6.00 from the ground. 2) For non-wall-mounted stands, the backdrop and the side partitions cannot exceed the height of mt. 5.00 from the ground. 3) Luminous signs (not intermittent) are allowed up to a height of mt. 5.00 from the ground as long as (in the organization's unquestionable judgment) they are installed so as not to damage adjacent exposures. It is also strictly forbidden to invade the passageways. 4) Applications of writing, signs, painting on glass and partition panels made available to the organization are prohibited. It is forbidden to plant nails or expansion plugs. It is mandatory to leave the emergency exits, the power outlets, as well as the fire prevention systems. If these provisions are not respected, the organization will be entitled to apply a fine equal to the value of the estimated damage. All the material used for the set-up must be of the self-extinguishing or fireproof type of fireproof at the origin, as required by the current fire prevention regulations issued by the Ministry of the Interior. Therefore, exhibitors who will set up the stand personally or by commissioning a fitting company will take note of their civil and criminal liability for any damage caused by non-compliance or violation of the fire prevention regulations and have the obligation to send within 15 days from the opening of the event a declaration of fire suitability of the materials used for this purpose. The exhibiting company that needs electricity on its stand must indicate this on request and

pay the fees for the right to connect to the general electricity grid and for consumption. It must either use its own staff or its own suppliers to set up the ground connections for lighting and power supply. It is necessary that exhibitors, who need electricity, are obliged to comply with the regulations in force, the technical standards in the installation of the system, for which a copy of the certificate (electric strip, electric panel) must be received upon registration. , etc.) attesting the conformity of the product. If this certificate is not presented, the Organizing Committee must provide for the supply of a certified product, otherwise the electricity will not be supplied and this supply will be charged to the exhibitor. It is mandatory to comply with the technical standards established by the CE in the assembly of the electrical system. Each system must have a differential switch (life-saver) of 0.03 A, flame-retardant cable and plug according to which the connections will be derived. The organization reserves the right to suspend the provision of technical services to exhibitors who do not comply with the prescribed standards. If the system has not been favorably verified, the official electrician will not carry out the connection to the general network until the exhibitor has made the necessary regulation. After the authorized connection and during further checks, the official electrician is also required to post those installations that do not correspond to the standards following tampering or alterations. The exhibitor who does not wish to provide directly to the electrical installation of his stand (differential switch, grounded socket for current supply, connection to the general electricity network and to any lighting system) can request it directly from MDexpo Srl The use of oxygen and helium cylinders only within the exhibition will be subject, in the ways, quantities and terms, to the written opinion of the supervisory bodies in charge according to the provisions of the law on safety. It is therefore mandatory to report to MDexpo S.r.l.s. prior to registration, the need to use gas cylinders containing the aforementioned gas, the number of cylinders and the certificate of suitability of the same. Art. XII

PARTICULAR PROHIBITIONS

It is explicitly forbidden to introduce explosive, detonating, asphyxiating or otherwise dangerous materials in the Exhibition enclosure, as it is forbidden to light fires with petrol

or other flammable material, without the required precautions and the necessary authorizations from the relevant Bodies. Participants are required to report the weight of the machines exceeding the load of 350 kg per square meter. and this in order to avoid damage and unforeseen accommodation works which could cause a greater expense for which the participant must repay the amount.

Art. XIII

GENERAL SURVEILLANCE - SUPERVISION - SECURITY

For the entire duration of the Event, as well as for the days set up for setting up and clearing the stands, the organizer provides a general day and night surveillance service within the Palasport, but does not assume any responsibility for theft and / or damage that may occur. During the entire opening time of the event, both in the setting up and dismantling phase, the exhibitor is required to guard and supervise his stands either directly or through his own staff. It is recommended to companies that display easily removable objects to stand on their stand for the duration of the daily schedule. The exhibitor is directly responsible for the behavior of his / her stand staff and thereby civilly and criminally raises the organizer.

Art. XIV

MACHINERY

No machinery may be put into action without prior written authorization from the organization and must not cause damage, danger, harassment or produce unpleasant fumes. The organization will ensure compliance with this rule, also making use of the laws and rules established in this regard. In any case, the machinery must be fitted with devices designed to prevent injuries and the emission of harmful or troublesome liquids or gases

Art. XV

RESPONSIBILITY / INSURANCE / INSURANCE COVERAGE OBLIGATION

The organization assumes no responsibility for damage caused to persons or things, by anyone and in any case caused. Consequently, damages resulting from theft, damage, fire, lightning, storms, explosions, water, rain or other causes are not compensated. Each exhibitor is fully responsible for his materials, his animals, his conduct and compliance with the regulations in force, throughout the stay on the premises, in the exhibition areas and will personally answer for any damage caused to the organization, the exhibition premises and the public. Every exhibitor is required to contract a policy that guarantees the exhibited assets, both owned and owned by third parties, against the risks of transport, storage and handling at the Exhibition (theft, fire, dampening, spraying and lightning) as well as transport back. The insurance must be taken out by the exhibitor at a leading company of his choice. For the display of functioning appliances and machines, the policy must specifically include the risks associated with the exposure of such equipment. By signing the General Regulations the exhibitor relieves the organizer, the organizers and third parties in any way interested in the event from any and all liability, renouncing from now on any compensation and / or request against them for any damage. suffered.

Art. XVI
COMPLAINTS

Any complaints from exhibiting companies must be presented to the organizer's offices within the duration of the event. Complaints submitted after this deadline will not be accepted. Communications and complaints of any kind will be considered only if submitted in writing. The decisions taken by the organizer are final and unquestionable. Therefore the exhibitors and their employees will have to respect the provisions that were given to them by the organization under penalty of exclusion from the Exhibition without any right to reimbursement or compensation and with the obligation to pay any damages that their non-compliances had procured.

Art. XVII
PUBLICITY AND PROPAGANDA

The organizer foresees the printing and distribution of an Exhibitor List, through a catalog and / or a giant map at the entrance and / or any other digital or paper support, during the Exhibition. The exhibiting companies will be mentioned in the publication. At the request of the exhibitors and upon payment, they can add other indications and request other forms of advertising. Inside the stand the exhibiting companies can only carry out that advertising action which, due to its appearance and substance, does not constitute a direct comparison with those of other exhibitors and which is not in any way disturbing to third parties. Any form of advertising in the sports hall, with the exception of that carried out inside the stands, is reserved for the organizer and will be granted by the organizer upon payment of the established fees. The video, videographic and sound equipment used in the stand must be declared to the SIAE 30 days before the start of the exhibition for the fulfillment of the prescribed rights, should video or sound produced by authors registered with the SIAE be transmitted.

Art. XVIII
SUSPENSION AND INTERRUPTION

Should the Show be suspended or interrupted for any reason whatsoever after it has been opened, the organization is not required to return all or part of the sums paid for any reason by the exhibitors. In the cases mentioned above it is excluded that the participants, by explicit agreement, can appeal against the Fair for any reason or cause. Under no circumstances will participants receive compensation or compensation of any kind.

Art.
XIX CHECKS

The organization may request the exhibitor to show the contents of containers or boxes that are not visible, within its own exhibition space, this also to ensure that there are no animals of prohibited or dangerous species.

Art. XX
GENERAL PROVISIONS

The exhibitor is obliged to comply with the provisions that the Public Security Authorities and those responsible for fire prevention, accident prevention and the supervision of premises open to the public should issue to the host structure. These last measures may be brought to the attention of the Exhibitors by any means, and will prevail over the general provisions previously adopted. The exhibitor and third parties on his behalf operating in the Exhibition Center must use personnel with employment, subordinate or autonomous employment relationships, meeting the requirements of the laws in force (regarding social security, insurance, taxation, etc.). The Exhibitor is responsible for paying SIAE rights, if musical motifs are distributed within the stand, even if only as a background. During the Exhibition, various conventions, competitions and events can be held. The organization reserves the right to issue additional rules or supplementary regulations to better organize the event. These provisions will have the same value as these General Regulations and will therefore be mandatory for all participants and their employees.

Art. XXI
GUARANTEE OF CONFIDENTIALITY

The data that will be provided by the exhibiting companies will be included in the organizer's databases and processed, in compliance with Legislative Decree 196/2003 on the protection of personal data, through various operations, carried out both on paper and with the aid of IT tools. The processing of data whose confidentiality is guaranteed is carried out for statistical, operational / strategic marketing purposes and to update the companies on the events organized by the organizer by sending informative material. The data will be entered exclusively in the official archive of the event and for them the exhibiting companies may request at any time, by writing to the data controller, confirmation of the existence or not of their data and their availability in an intelligible way .

Art. XXII
READ ANIMALS EXPOSURE AND SALE

1. It is absolutely forbidden to exhibit, sell or even bring within the fair any species included in the LIST OF DANGEROUS ANIMALS carried out by the Ministerial Decree dated 19-04-1996, 15-05-2001, 03-07- 2003.

2. OTHER COMPANION MAMMALS: The basic size of the container always refers to 2 animals.

The shorter side of the base must be at least equal to the length of the animal with a tail.

The height of the container must be at least once the length

of the animal with the tail for land animals; for arboreal ones the height must be at least 3 times the length of the animal with the tail.

SMALL (Up to 150 grams in weight): 500 cm².

MEDIUM / SMALL (Up to 600 grams in weight): 900cm².

MEDIUM (up to 1kg in weight): 2000cm².

MEDIUM / LARGE (Up to 5 kg in weight): 3600 cm²

LARGE (Greater than 5 kg) 3x2 the length of the animal with a tail

3 SAURI. The basic size of the container always refers to 2 animals. The base of the container must be at least twice the length of the animal, the width and height at least equal to the length. For each additional animal each side must increase by 10%. In addition, for the arboreal animals, branches and climbers must be prepared for at least twice the length of the animal.

4 SERPENTS. The basic size of the container always refers to 2 animals. The perimeter of the container must be at least 1.25 times the total length of the animal. For each additional animal it is necessary to calculate in addition 10% of the perimeter. The width of the

container must be at least 25% of the length of the animal. For arboreal snakes the height of the container must be at least equal to at least 25% of the animal and the container must be provided with branches and climbers.

5 TERRESTRIAL TURTLES. The basic size of the container always refers to 2 animals. The floor area must be at least 20 times that of the animal's carapace. The smaller side of the container must be at least twice the length of the carapace of the larger animal. For each additional animal it is necessary to calculate in addition 25% of the floor area.

6 AQUATIC TURTLES. The basic size of the container always refers to 2 animals. The container must have an area at least equal to fivefold for twice the length of the carapace of the larger animal. The dry part must be at least equal to the surface of the carapace of the larger animal. The aquatic part must be at least twice the length of the largest carapace. For each additional animal it is necessary to calculate in addition 25% of the surface, both aquatic and terrestrial.

7 BIRDS: The space of each cage / aviary must be conformed and sufficient to allow all the animals to move freely and at the same time without risk of compromising the flight feathers and helmsman. They must also be able to open both wings without touching the walls of the cage itself and without touching the bottom with the helmsman's feathers.

As the sole custodian of its area, the exhibitor undertakes to substantially and procedurally indemnify the organization of Firenze Wild, to keep it free from any loss, damage, liability, cost or expense, including legal ones deriving from the use of the assigned area .

Art. XXIII

ACCEPTANCE OF THE REGULATION

By submitting the application form and signing these General Regulations, each exhibitor accepts the aforementioned conditions and regulations that may be issued by the organizer, which will then be legitimized, in the event of non-compliance with these obligations, all its regulatory provisions and all legal regulations to intervene directly, acting also with its own service personnel in the Exhibition Center. It also subscribes and accepts the attached regulation concerning the animals exhibited during the event called "ANIMAL EXPOSURE AND MAINTENANCE RULES" (referring to exhibitors interested in the Florence Wild 2019 exhibition and maintenance regulations). Any verbal agreements must be confirmed in writing by the organizer.
